## SKILLS ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

### **Nursing Skills**

Program

ADVOCAP, in partnership with WISCAP, has launched a new Nursing Skills Program (NSP).

NSP is intended for those interested in becoming a Nursing Assistant, CNA, RN or LPN.

This program is available to anyone who resides in Fond du Lac, Green Lake, or Winnebago Counties and whose household income is at or below 80% of their counties median income. There is no work requirement for this program. Participants must be enrolled in an accredited school or training center and be able to complete their program and be working in their field by June 1, 2025.



# The NSP provides participants up to \$25,000 in financial assistance for the following:

- Tuition, books, and other required supplies for their program
- Assistance with mileage to and from school
- Assistance with childcare expenses while attending classes

## **Skills Enhancement**

#### Program

ADVOCAP's original Skills Enhancement Program (SEP) has a wider scope of available education opportunities.

SEP assists participants in pursuing a career in any one of Wisconsin's "in demand fields."

In-demand fields include business, logistics, medical, manufacturing, welding, childcare, just to name a few. Participants must have income at or below 150% to poverty for their family size, be working an average of 20 hours per week and reside in Fond du Lac, Green Lake, or Winnebago Counties.



#### The SEP provides participants the following:

- Up to \$900 per semester for tuition, books, and other required supplies
- Up to \$100 per month for mileage assistance
- Up to \$125 per month for childcare while attending classes
