ADVOCAP's Opportunity Center is **a safe and welcoming space** for low-income individuals to access a wide array of support services. Whether someone needs **help navigating complex systems**, accessing basic necessities, or simply finding a safe place to spend the day, **the Center is there to provide assistance**.

Through a comprehensive intake process, ADVOCAP **staff assess an individual's needs** and connect them with relevant organizations and resources. Staff help to **break down barriers** finding long-term, holistic solutions and **pathways out of poverty**.

The Center currently offers support in these areas:

Basic needs

Connection to FoodShare, medical insurance, P.O. boxes, cell phone and email registration.

Shelter assistance

Help finding temporary shelter, particularly for those who cannot sleep on public property without facing legal consequences.

Employment support

Support with resumes, job search, interview scheduling and preparation.


Mental health and wellness

Connection to specialized services addressing challenges such as substance use disorders, trauma, and mental health needs.
